

NOTICE TO PROSPECTIVE BUYERS OF PROPERTIES

This is to notify you that the home you are about to purchase, located at

is in the vicinity of the E.I. Dupont de Nemours Antioch Works Plant, located north of Highway 4, west of Big Break Road, Antioch, California. This plant stores and/or processes large quantities of chlorine, hydrochloric acid, hydrofluoric acid, sulfur dioxide, and titanium tetrachloride, all hazardous or acutely hazardous substances. Chlorine is a greenish-yellow gas with a pungent, irritating odor. Hydrogen fluoride is a colorless gas with a strong, irritating odor. They are both poisonous and may be fatal if inhaled at high concentration (equal to or greater than 30 parts per million). Sulfur dioxide is a colorless gas with a pungent irritating odor, immediately dangerous at concentrations over 100 parts per million.

While large spills of hazardous substances have historically been essentially contained within the industrial property and significant releases are considered unlikely by the industry, it is possible that a significant accidental release could occur, thereby placing people nearby at risk of harmful exposure. In such an event, local authorities may request that you evacuate your home or that you take other protective action.
